The agenda was presented in detail to the commission.


The CM thanks the organizers for the good preparation and the loving details.

6. Decision to the competition age

- Ignaz Mascha
 - o in Opole the participation of younger participants was possible (ten-year-old)
 - In Lisbon the age structure was broken down (3 ten-year-old 0,74 %; 17 11-year-old 4,21 %)
 - 1 competition group from 11 years, all younger participants are rated in this group
 - o Proposal: regulations from Opole should be used in Villach

Because of the participation of younger competitors the measures of the competition devices will not be changed.

7. Decision about additional female groups

- > Ignaz Mascha
 - o 33 groups boys and mixed in Opole, 9 groups girls
 - o The possibility to specifically send female groups should be given to the nations
 - Proposal: In addition to the two nation groups one more, than a complete female group, can be sent, if the accommodation by the organizer is possible (so maximum two male or female groups)
 - o In Villach the accommodation is possible
 - Additional raters are not necessary
 - o The duration of the competition will not be changed dramatically
 - Due to the accommodation the regulation should be examined from event to event.

8. Raters training 2016

> Ignaz Mascha

- o 14.-16.10.2016 in Linz
- o At the same time, training for raters of the adult groups
- o 3 raters per nation, who are planned to be in Villach
- The amount of mistakes is decreasing through training
- o The level of education is put on an equal level
- o June/July the registration will be sent
- o Participants are supposed to be familiar with the competition
- o goal: fair rating of all participants in the competition

➤ CM

- o CTIF will bear the costs (accommodation and food)
- Traveling costs are payed by the nations
- The despatch of the invitations will be coordinated with the representative for the adults

9. XXI. Meeting of Youth Fire Brigades 2017

➤ CM

- o 09.-16.07.2017 in Villach
- Optimal conditions for the event
- Wide support by fire brigade and administration
- Villach offers opportunity for more groups than before (see item 7)
- Next meeting for preparation on 03.06.2016
- Attendance fee: 201,- € (193,- € for organizer, 8,- € for CTIF)
 - A bit more expensive than Opole

Manfred Eibl

- o Presentation of the programme
 - Presentation as ppt. in attachment
- The delegation leaders will have separate accommodation (not with the youngsters)
 - The commission agrees with this procedure
- The nation's groups are supposed to be housed together if possible
- Shuttle service to the training will be prepared
- Presentation of the nations in small huts over two days on the market place
- The participants of the competition are asked to bring a sleeping bag and a pillow

➤ CM

- The public is, like in Opole, supposed to be well informed and included
- Finland takes care for the Olympics
- Germany takes care for the exhibition and presentation of the nations
- Camp management please again with John Cartwright like in Opole coordination with GB necessary
- F-DISK for registration in Opole was not optimal, therefore input by Excel sheets and then input into F-DISK

10. XXII. Meeting of Youth Fire Brigades 2019

➤ CM

- o fire brigade association of Switzerland is interested
- should take place near Interlaken
- o allocation by delegates 'meeting of CTIF
- no preparations without decision by CTIF
- Commission will catch a predecision

Decision:

- Commission agrees to the application of Switzerland in unison
- Subject to the local conditions
- CM and the international competition leader will visit the sites and give a recommendation for the delegates 'meeting in Helsinki
- Attendance fees have to be determined up in the run-up (note by Poland)



- Regarding to the shortening of the meeting until now no agreement is reached
 - 2 working groups in the meeting in Lisbon were for a shortening by one day, with equal costs
 - 1 working group in Lisbon was against a shortening, to experience the host country

Vote:

- Poland against a shortening, to little free time for participants
- Finland does not support a shortening, because there is not really saving potential
- Slovenia is against a shortening
- Austria recommends a whole week
- Italy supports a shortening
- Great Britain thinks that a shortening to Saturday makes sense in the youth meeting
- Luxemburg likes to leave it like it is
- Croatia supports a shortening to tighten the event
- France is fundamental against a shortening
- Germany is against a shortening
- Czech Republic has no clear opinion and abstains
- > CM
 - Don't forget: it is not only about the competition but also a youth meeting and that needs time
 - o An earlier voluntary journey home is not easy to plan

11. Discussion CTIF official language

- ➤ CM
 - Again and again problems with translations and understanding
 - o Push in the CTIF, determine English as only language
- Zdenek Nytra
 - o Discussions are not finished yet
 - Time and money play a role by the translation
 - Addresses are extended by translation into several languages
 - French is not represented so often
 - o In German should be preserved, in addition
- ➤ CM
- o In the commission, German should be preserved (earlier decision)
- Symposium is carried out only into English, because English is spread more among the youngsters
- To 01.08.2016 the members of the commission should inform whether there should remain three languages or should be reduced (see proposal CTIF vice president Davis)



12. Presentation membership campaign Austria

- Extensive campaign about print media, radio, social media, posters
 - o Total costs 150.000,- €
 - Flyers for all states individually
 - o Accompanying there was rolling ups, give-aways etc. for the member's acquisition
 - o Small increase with the memberships

 - o Big jubilee to 1,050 years of "baptism" in Poland
 - Big campfire on the highest Polish mountain, all 5 minutes other fires were lighted in completely Poland
 - Only two weeks to prepare
- Finland
 - $\circ \quad \text{Summer camp, all nations can attend} \\$
- Slovenia
 - o 2 big events
 - June national competitions with more than 2.000 participates
 - July meeting with Croatian youngsters
- Austria
 - Campaign for fire prevention education with material for kindergartens and schools
 - Preparations for federal competition are running
- Italy
 - End of June, big camp
 - Will be carried out on the market place of Trento
- Great Britain
 - Changes in the organisation
 - o Standardization in the UK aimed
- Luxemburg
 - Big tent camp planned
 - o Book about 50 years of Luxemburg's youth fire brigade planned
- Croatia
 - o Concentration on competitions for children between 6 and 16
 - Camp planned ca. 1.200 participants
 - Training for youth leaders
 - Month of the fire prevention
- > France
 - o Big event 01.-03.07. in Verdun with 1.500 participants (competitions)
